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Road Watch Update March 19 – March 25, 2020

McGregor Blvd from Jambalana Lane to Biltmore Drive

The north bound lane of McGregor Blvd will be closed on **Thursday March 24, 2020 between 7:00 p.m. and 12:30 a.m.** to repair a stormwater pipe. The east sidewalk will also be closed during this time. Flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists through the area.

Hotel Indigo Re-roof Project

Main St. between **Monroe St. and Broadway Avenue** will experience intermittent road closures starting **February 17 thru March 30, 2020**. Target Roofing will be working on reroofing the Hotel Indigo and will need to use a crane to transport materials to and from the roof. Please expect the roads closed (most of the time) from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. while the crane is in operation. The sidewalks will remain blocked off for pedestrian safety.

Virginia Avenue Road Closure at City Walk

Virginia Ave. will be closed **January 21 thru April 30, 2020** between McGregor Blvd. and West First St. by Brooks and Freund, LLC. The purpose of this closure is to tie in the sewer line from the large manhole located in the middle of the road.

Brooks and Freund will also have intermittent lane closures of West First St. between Altamonte and Virginia Ave. for the next 3 months starting March 9, 2020. They will also be bringing the construction fence north of the property closing the sidewalk along the north side of their property for safety reason. They will be using a crane to put up the walls on this side of the property.

Local Traffic **only** will be able to access their driveways from either McGregor Blvd. or West First St.

North Entrance to South Plaza/Colonial Boulevard - Canal Bridge Replacement

Crews will be removing and replacing the canal bridge at the north entrance to South Plaza, located on the south side of Colonial Boulevard between Tilton Court and US 41 (Cleveland Avenue). Colonial Boulevard north entrance driveway to South Plaza will be closed during

construction. Driveway access to Baer's Furniture will be maintained. Motorists should access South Plaza from (US 41/S) Cleveland Avenue. **The expected completion date is March 2020.**

Cleveland Grove Utility Improvement Project

This project is scheduled to replace sanitary sewer and water main, install storm drainage improvements and regrade swales on Turner Street, Patrick Avenue and Kentucky Avenue. The project also includes new sidewalks on the west side of Turner Street, the north side of Patrick Avenue, the east side of Kentucky Avenue and roadway

Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard from Marion Street to Brookhill Drive - Traffic intermittently reduced to one lane Wednesday, March 19. Flaggers will maintain two-way alternating traffic. Motorists should expect delays.

Patrick Avenue is closed at Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard.

- Closure will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.
- Residents will need to access Patrick Avenue via Marion Street to Turner Street.

Construction remains active on Kentucky Avenue, Turner Street and Patrick Avenue.

Crews are working in and near the roadways. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering / exiting streets in the project area. Flaggers will be onsite during normal work hours to assist motorists through the construction zone. This schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. The project is expected to be completed in spring 2020.

Hanson Street Extension, Phase II from Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard to Ortiz Avenue

The second phase of the Hanson Street Extension from west of Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard to Ortiz Avenue includes building new roadway, installing new sanitary sewer force main and potable and reclaim water mains as well as six-foot sidewalks, seven-foot bike lanes, and two roundabouts. One roundabout will be located at Hanson Street and Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard intersection and the other will be located at Hanson Street Extension and Ortiz Avenue intersection. This project is anticipated to be completed at the end of 2020.

VERONICA S. SHOEMAKER BOULEVARD AT THE HANSON STREET ROUNDABOUT

Beginning Monday, **March 23 through Friday, March 27** night time/overnight work **from 7 p.m. through 5 a.m.** Motorists should expect northbound and southbound temporary lane closures and lane shifts on Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard while crews install light poles.

Motorists can expect Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard northbound lane to be reduced to one lane during a pole installation.

HANSON STREET EAST OF VERONICA S. SHOEMAKER BOULEVARD REMAINS CLOSED TO THROUGH TRAFFIC.

- Businesses between Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard and Van Buren Street are accessible.
- Closure will remain in place during daytime and night time/overnight hours.

ORTIZ AVENUE NORTH OF VINCE SMITH DRIVE – Motorists should expect trucks entering and exiting roadway.

This schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. Motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists should use extreme caution.

Wastewater Interconnect Project – Phase III, Part IV Coronado Road

This project is from South to Central Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plants. Phase III of the project replaces underground sewer pipe along Coronado Road from Cortez Boulevard to US-41, Nelson Street from Coronado Road to Braman Avenue, east on Braman Avenue to Grand Avenue, and north on Grand Avenue to Hanson Street.

Coronado Road from Sunset Road to US-41/Cleveland Avenue is intermittently closed to through traffic. Through traffic to follow detour signs. Local traffic will be accommodated. Motorists can expect delays.

Some sidewalks may be closed during the project. Crews are working in and near the roadway. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area. Flaggers will be onsite during normal work hours to assist motorists through the construction zone. This schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. Phase III of this project is expected to be completed in spring 2020.

FDOT Pedestrian Safety Construction Project on US 41 from Winkler Avenue to SR 82/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard entails installing and relocating utilities and constructing medians on US 41/Cleveland Avenue from Winkler Avenue to SR 82.

- **Motorists should expect a new traffic pattern from Coronado Road to south of Linhart Avenue.**

- **Motorists should expect intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures and detours on US 41/Cleveland Avenue during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours Monday through Friday throughout the duration of the project, weather permitting.**
- **Motorists should expect side road closures from Winkler Avenue to Victoria Avenue throughout the duration of the project.**

Additional work includes: Installing drainage structures, pedestrian signals, upgrading signals and lighting, and resurfacing existing highway. The project will be constructed in three segments. Each segment will have the majority of construction completed prior to moving to the next segment. Construction will begin on the first segment from Winkler Avenue to Carrell Road. Crews will work on the west side of the road initially and when that work is completed, they will shift to the east side of Cleveland Avenue/US 41. I-75 at Daniels Parkway - Mile Marker 131

Construction project: Crews will be installing a parking detection system in the northbound and southbound rest area parking areas. Motorists should use caution as crews work near the roadway. Estimated completion date is end of spring 2020. The contractor is Florida Safety Contractors, Inc.

SR 884/Colonial Boulevard from US 41 to Winkler Avenue: Construction project: Crews will be installing lighting at the following intersections: US 41, Evans Avenue, Metro Parkway, McGregor Baptist Church, Veronica S. Shoemaker Boulevard, and Winkler Avenue. **Work will occur during nighttime/overnight hours from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.** Motorist should expect delays and use caution while traveling in this area. Estimated project completion is late spring 2020. The contractor is Traffic Control Devices, Inc.

SR 739/Business 41 from the Edison Bridge to south of West North Shore Ave: Maintenance contract project: Motorists should expect northbound and southbound lane closures during nighttime/overnight hours from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. while crews repair asphalt, weather permitting. Motorists should use caution as crews work on the roadway.

SR 82 from Arcadia Street to Shawnee Road: Maintenance contract project: Motorists should expect intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures during nighttime/overnight hours from 7 p.m. to 4 a.m., while crews inspect the road, weather permitting. Motorist should use caution as crews work in the roadway.
