



The City of Fort Myers is in the process of completing the 5th Program Year Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report Plan. The plan provides an opportunity to evaluate the housing and community development accomplishment and performance for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funds. The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) allocates approximately \$625,000 in grants funds to the City's CDBG program each year. The funds were used to develop stronger communities by providing decent housing, creating suitable living environments, and expanding economic opportunities, principally for low- to moderate-income persons that reside within the City limits.
